Stevens Large Tree Sales is in transition.

J&J Trees Inc. have purchased our 42", 65", and 90" truck spades and will provide all of the tree planting services.

We will continue to maintain our tree farm and provide tree sales, site visits and quoting.

All the trees in this price list require equipment for handling the trees, as rootballs will weigh from 2000 lbs (2250kg) to 10,000 lbs (4500kg), which means we do not plant trees in backyards unless we are able to access the backyard with our truck spades.

You are welcome to visit our tree farm anytime during daylight hours, but an appointment is necessary if you require consultation.

Our Preferred Consultation Process

1 - Site Visit... *to your property to assess the project, determine the variety of tree(s) that will be suitable, the location where the tree(s) will be planted, number of trees required, and any access limitations [which may determine the size of tree(s) that can be planted].*

2 - Your Budget... *Knowing your estimated budget to supply and plant would be helpful, as prices vary considerably depending on variety and tree size.*

3 - Selection of Trees... *by us, or by the customer, or both*

4 - Quote Presentation & Quote Acceptance.

5 - Place Yellow Stakes... *where your tree(s) are to be planted (by us, or by the customer, or both).*

6 - Locates are Requested ... *hydro, gas, telephone, water lines etc. (requests are usually done by us, the contractor).*

7 - Planting is then Scheduled... *based on weather and workload.*

Availability

We only sell trees that are listed in this price list.

The availability of certain tree sizes may be limited.

A few of the tree species and sizes are not for sale at this time as we must give these trees time to grow. It takes 6 to 15 years for the trees in our nursery to reach our saleable size.

Truck and tree spade access limitations:

- Most trees can be planted in spring, summer and fall.
- All our trucks are 8' 6" wide.
- 45" truck mounted tree spade requires minimum width of 10' for access clearance. 12' if driving between houses. Digs evergreen trees up to 10' high.
- 65" truck mounted tree spade requires minimum width of 12' for access clearance. 15' if driving between houses. Digs shade trees up to 5.5" trunk diameter & evergreen trees up 15' high.
- 90" truck mounted tree spade requires minimum width of 12' for access clearance. 20' if driving between houses. Digs shade trees up to 9" trunk diameter & evergreen trees up 25' high.

Additional charges:

- Add an additional 4% per km to planting charges when beyond the 15km radius of our tree farm (Stouffville). Tree price does not change.
- Topdressing trees using triple mix soil, mulch and staking (when necessary) is an additional charge. This will vary on number and size of trees, and travel distance from the farm. (Approx. \$50-\$150/tree).

Warranty Terms:

All trees purchased and installed by us are guaranteed for 2 years from date of invoice. Additional charges may be required if conditions have changed from original installation (e.g. access due to fences, buildings and other obstructions). In no case shall Stevens Large Tree Sales be liable for the loss or damage to trees caused by wind storm, hail, lightning, fire, lack of water, excessive water, road salt damage, contaminated soil, vandalism, or malicious acts. Warranty is void when surrounding grade level is raised higher than the level that the tree was planted.

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Caring for Your New Tree(s)

TRANSPLANT SHOCK:

Trees are generally transplanted with only a small proportion of their root system and must spend the first few seasons growing sufficient roots to support new twig growth. As a result, newly planted trees tend to have small leaves, some shoots die back, and the crown may look thin in the 2nd and 3rd year.

WATERING:

Regular watering is important to establish a strong root system. Do not water every day. Infrequent, deep soakings are better than frequent, shallow watering. Soil should be kept moist at all times; **however, too much watering may drown the roots, causing leaves to turn yellow and fall off.** (I call this loving tree to death). Keep in mind if trees are not timely watered, the trees will get more stressed, resulting in much longer time for the tree to reestablish and start growing again.

Guidelines for watering:

May to September: Water Day 1 & 5, and then once every 10 to 15 days. Stop watering by mid-September. October and November planting - Give the tree one good soaking this year and then water next year as per instructions in next paragraph.

Trees must also be watered in the 2nd year during long hot, dry periods in the summer. Start around mid-June. Don't let trees go without a substantial watering (50/60 gallons) for more than 3 weeks. Hopefully mother nature will help with some timely heavy rains. Trees require at least 1" (25mm) of rain per week.

TREE ROOTS:

Tree roots are vital to a tree's survival. Many people do not realize that roots require oxygen as well as water and nutrients. Soil compaction or raising the ground level around the base of a tree reduces available oxygen to the roots and may cause poor tree growth or death. In urban areas, roots are close to the surface and may be easily damaged by gardening or landscaping. Planting flowers at the base of the tree may also be detrimental if roots are cut during soil cultivation. Whenever possible, try to create mulch around the base of the tree using organic material such as shredded leaves or wood mulch.

FERTILIZING:

Nitrogen rich fertilizers should not be added immediately after planting as this may promote twig growth before the roots have had a chance to recover. We suggest "plant starter" (e.g., 10-52-10) to help promote root growth. Nitrogen rich fertilizer may benefit the tree in the 2nd or 3rd year, particularly if leaves are yellowish in colour and small.

REMEMBER... Caring for your trees after planting is as important as the planting process itself. There is no doubt that trees are worth protecting - they are an investment and add thousands of dollars of real value to your home.

Protect your trees for their beauty and value.
